2. Original admit card of JEE (Advanced)-2018 Examination.
3. Proof of payment made at the time of seat allocation.
4. Class X (High School) mark sheet and Board Certificate (if applicable) original and two copies.
5. Class XII mark sheets and pass certificate in original and two copies.
6. Medical fitness certificate in case it is not submitted at the reporting centre.
7. Photographs: passport size (8), stamp size (4).
8. Valid certificate of category in the JEE prescribed format (OBC (NCL)/SC/ST/PwD/DS) issued by a competent authority.
9. Copy of Aadhar Card/Any document issued by the Government regarding address proof (if copy of aadhar is not available)
10. In case the student plans to apply for any institute scholarship* (s)he should bring,
 - i. Family income certificate issued by the authorized officials in Revenue Deptt./DC/SDM/Tehsildar, etc. A self attested copy of Income Certificate be deposited at the time of admission and original needs to be submitted at the time of submission of claim for scholarship.
 - ii. Duly filled up and signed income affidavit. Link given below:

Please bring **soft copies** (scanned copies) of your class X, class XII mark sheets, pass certificates, photograph, Aadhar card/Voters ID/Passport, and Category certificate (if applicable) as well. This would help speed up your online registration process on 30th July, 2018.

As per MHRD order eligible students may avail below concession:

1. The most economically backward students (whose family income is less than Rs.1 lakh per annum) shall get full remission of tuition fee.
2. The other economically backward students (whose family income is between Rs.1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of tuition fee.

For availing this concession please bring family income certificate issued by the authorized officials in Revenue Deptt./DC/SDM/Tehsildar, etc. and affidavit signed by Notary.

The program aims to help students acclimatize to their new environment, rediscover the joy of learning, absorb curricular materials and institutional ethos with greater ease, and enrich the quality of faculty-student interactions in the years to come. Various activities have been designed for these five weeks, with the objective of helping all students engage in self-reflection, gain proficiency in essential skills expected in engineering students, understand what is engineering, explore their creative selves, and build healthy lifestyles. The activities are categorized into the following broad areas:


- 1) Proficiency Courses in Computers, English & Communication and Visual Thinking.

4. **Scholarships for Female Students:** From the academic year 2017-18 onwards, all female students admitted to the B.Tech. program are provided with a merit scholarship including full tuition fee waiver and Rs.1,000/- per month stipend. This merit scholarship will continue till 4th year subject to good academic performance of the candidate indicated by a minimum SGPA criteria of 7.0 for the previous two semesters and no disciplinary action.
