

The first batch of students shift into the North Campus, IIT Mandi



On Saturday, 6th August 2016, 20 new PG students made history by being the first batch to shift into the North Campus at Kamand. Earlier in 2012, first batch of students, the Director and few faculties shifted to Kamand (South Campus), which is now a fully residential campus with all the facilities. The fresh PG students have occupied rooms in the new B22 Hostel block. More students and several faculty with families will be following them in the weeks ahead.

On 8th Aug, Orientation for about 80 new PG students was held. These include pioneering students in new programmes: M.Tech. (Biotech), M.Sc. (Applied Maths), M.Tech. (EE – VLSI)

in addition to the ongoing M.Sc. (Chemistry), M.Tech. (ME-Energy), iPh.D. (Physics), and M.S./Ph.D. in sciences, engineering and the humanities. The high tea at the end of the Orientation was served in the new B22 Hostel.
