1. Full-time Ph.D. Program

Minimum Eligibility:

- Postgraduate degree in Anthropology, Sociology, Political Science, Economics, English, Philosophy, or related disciplines with a minimum 55% mark or CGPA of 6.0 on 10 points. The candidates belonging to reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC, PWD) will be given relaxation as per institute norms.
- Must have qualified UGC–JRF/NET/GATE/ or equivalent examination.

- A research scholar under the External Registration Program normally carries out part or all of the research work at the place of employment under the supervision of a co-supervisor also employed in the same organization and a supervisor at IIT Mandi.
